

Cancellation Policy (MAGA)

If the obligations are not fulfilled by either party because of extenuating circumstances, no mandatory penalties will be applied to either party. Example: Inclement weather (prohibiting travel) or grave illness. Our policy is to let the judge(s) decide. They know their comfort level and driving abilities. Assigner(s) and carpooling judges will not be involved with the ultimate decision of any individual judge. Assigner(s) and carpooling judges will not encourage or argue with the ultimate decision made by the judge(s). They are adults, know their limitations/abilities, and we trust that if they can't make it safely, they know best. Judges are expected to plan the drive time appropriately for safe travel and arrive on time.

When very extreme inclement weather starts during the competition (weather which delays or prohibits safe travel for the judges home), the Meet Director is responsible for the judges' lodging and meals. Judges will be accommodated with minimal expense and could be lodged in private homes with food provided. Hotel/Motel rooms are compensated ONLY if approved by the Meet Director.

During the day of the meet, it is best for the judging group to communicate directly with the club and not through the assigner.
